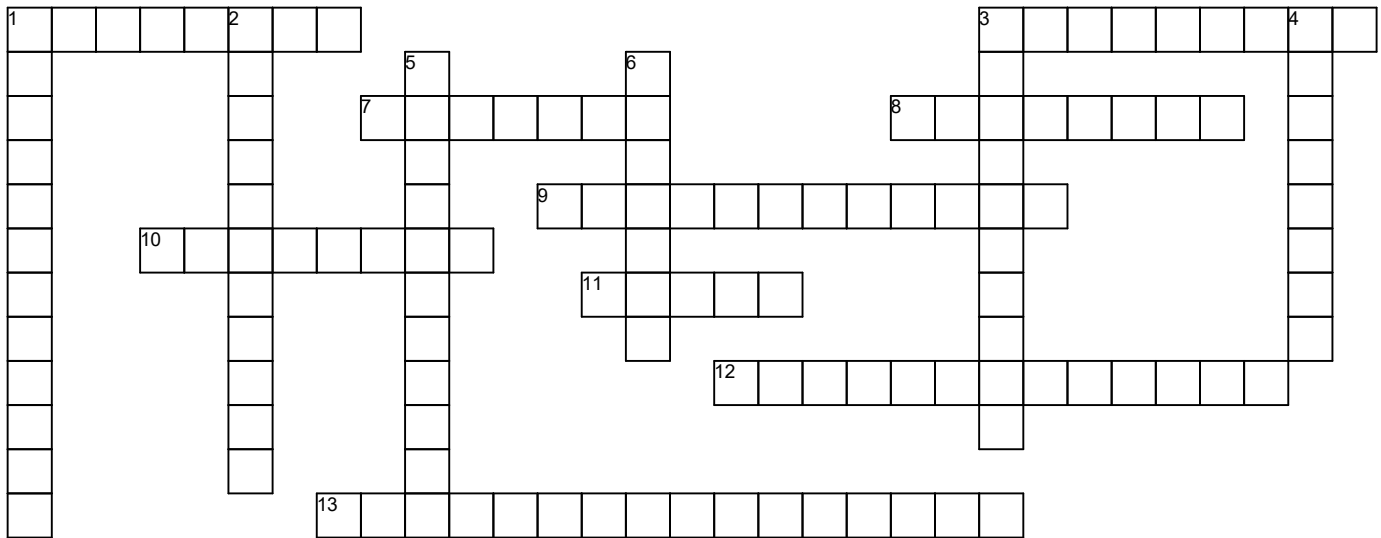


Biology Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 14

4. Tiny organisms that float in the water.
