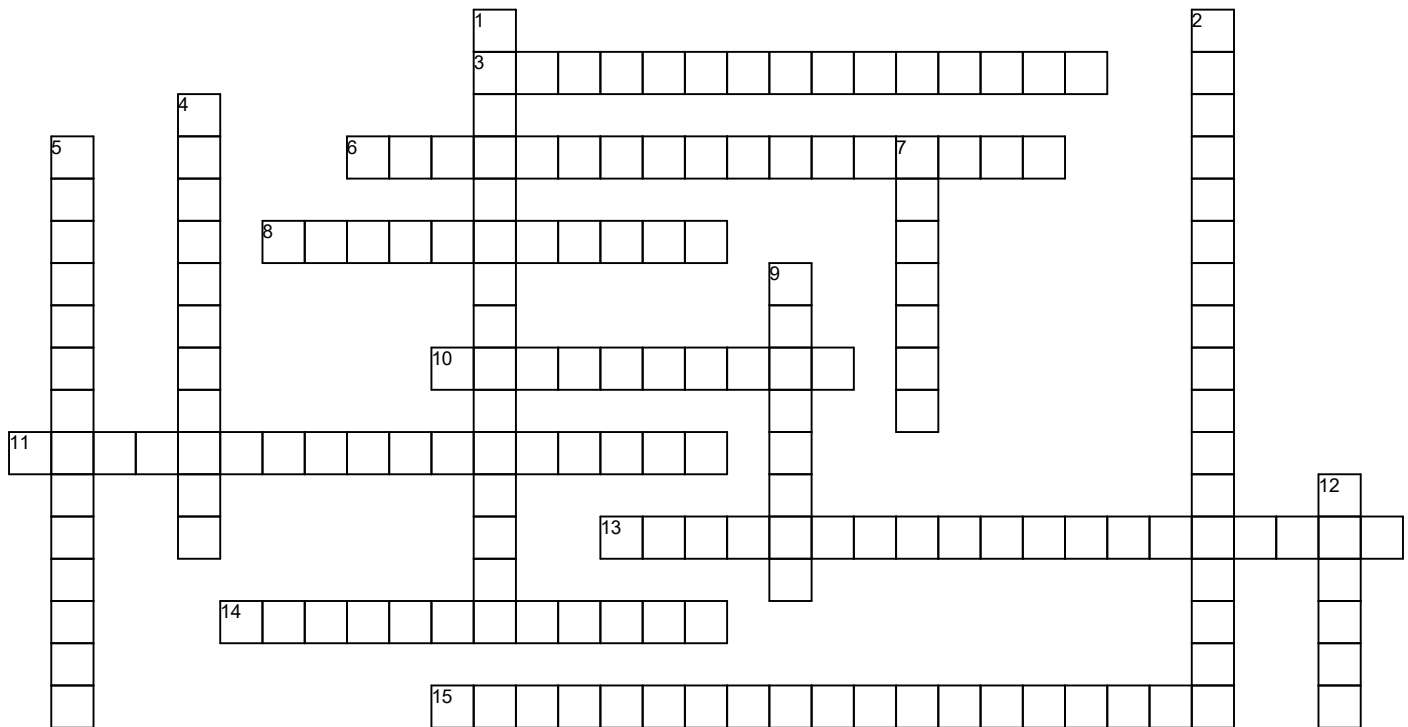


Biology Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 15
