
Biology Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 16

- 1. A community (or biome) that is dominated by grasses, has few trees, and is characterized by cold winters and rainfall that is intermediate between that of a forest and a desert.
- 4. Biome characterized by broad-leaved, deciduous trees, well-defined seasons, and average yearly precipitation of 75-150 cm.
- 7. A tiny, nonliving particle that invades and then reproduces inside a living cell.
- 9. An organism that eats secondary consumers.
- 10. A change in genotype and phenotype due to the assimilation of external DNA by a cell.
- 11. Tiny floating organisms that are either small animals or protozoa.
- 12. Cell organelle that stores materials such as water, salts, proteins, and carbohydrates.
- 13. Protects and supports body organs and provides a framework the muscles use to support movement. Made up of bones and joints.

- 1. Evaporation of water from the leaves of a plan.
- 2. Warm, long days; very diverse; over 200 cm of precipitation per year.
- 3. The fertilized egg; it enters a 2-week period of rapid cell division and develops into an embryo.

- 6. A harmless variant or derivative of a pathogen that stimulates a host's immune system to mount defenses against the pathogen.
- 7. Bottom portion of the heart, thicker walled and larger.
