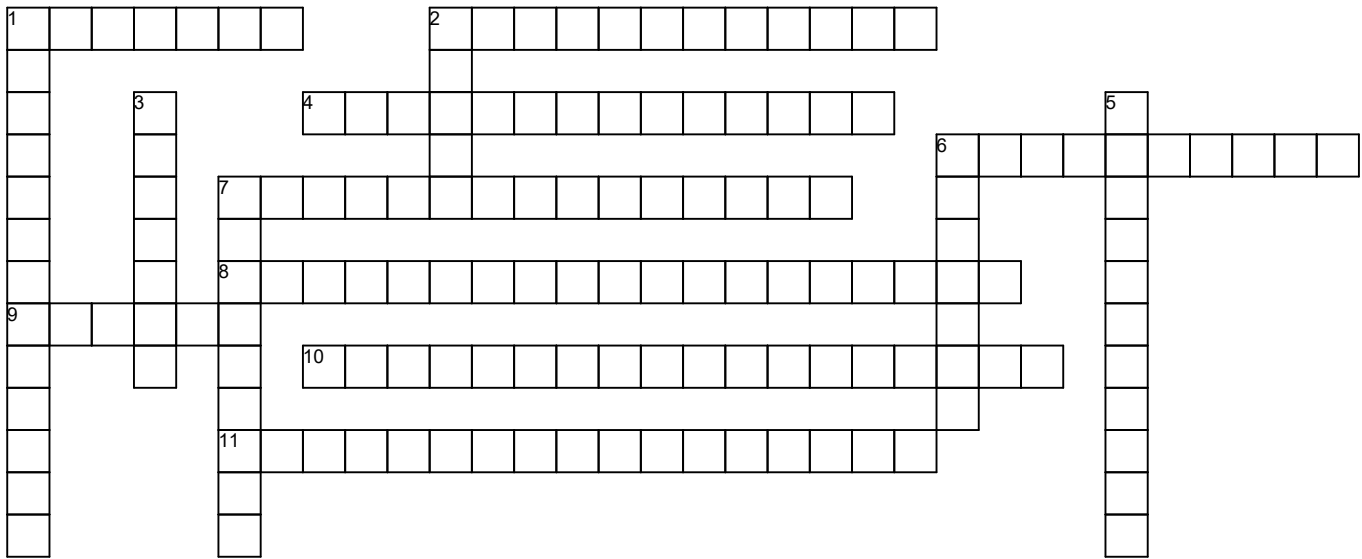


Biology Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 25
