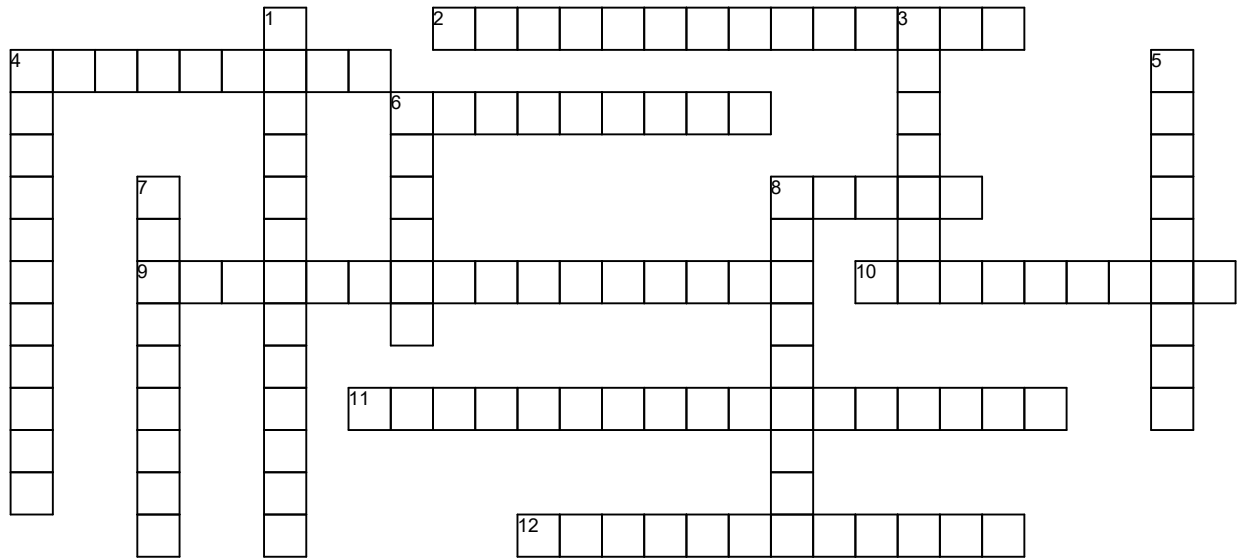


Biology Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 27
