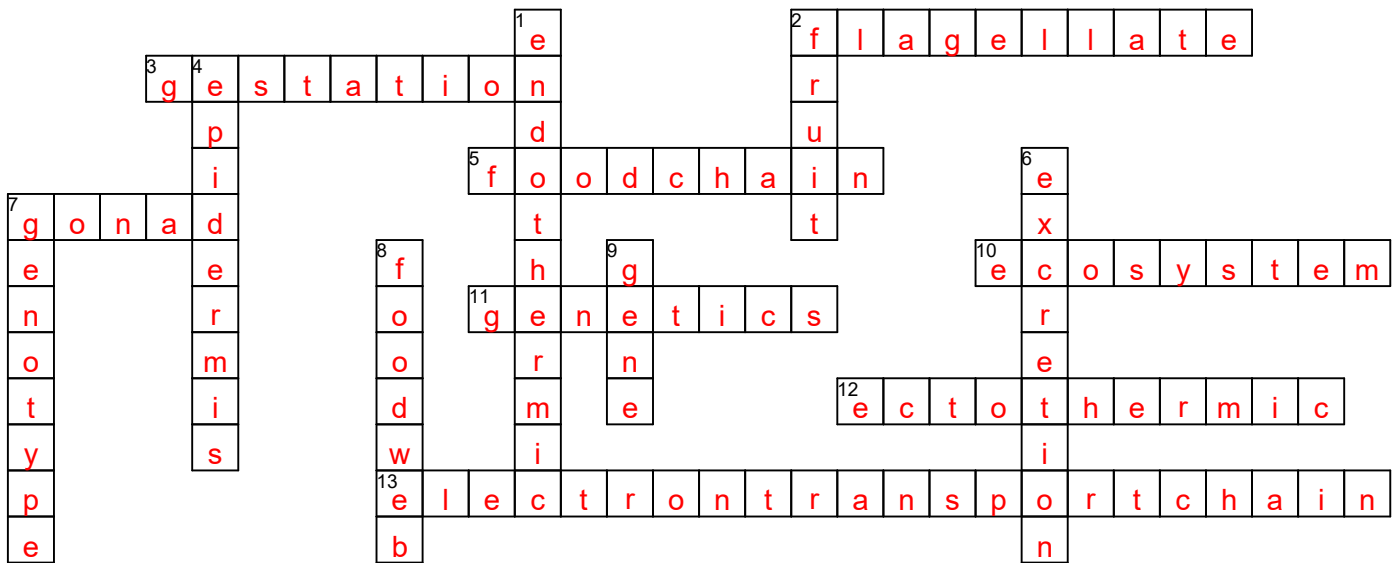


Biology Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 28
