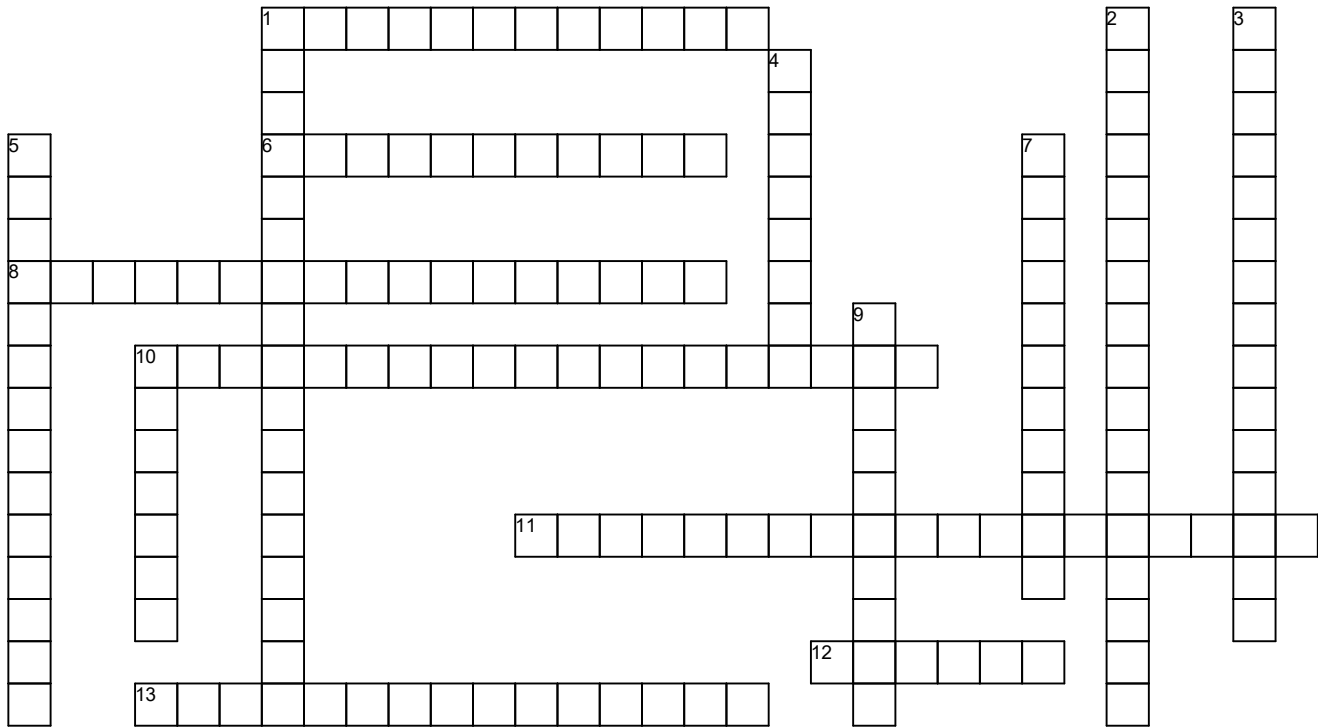


Biology Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 31
