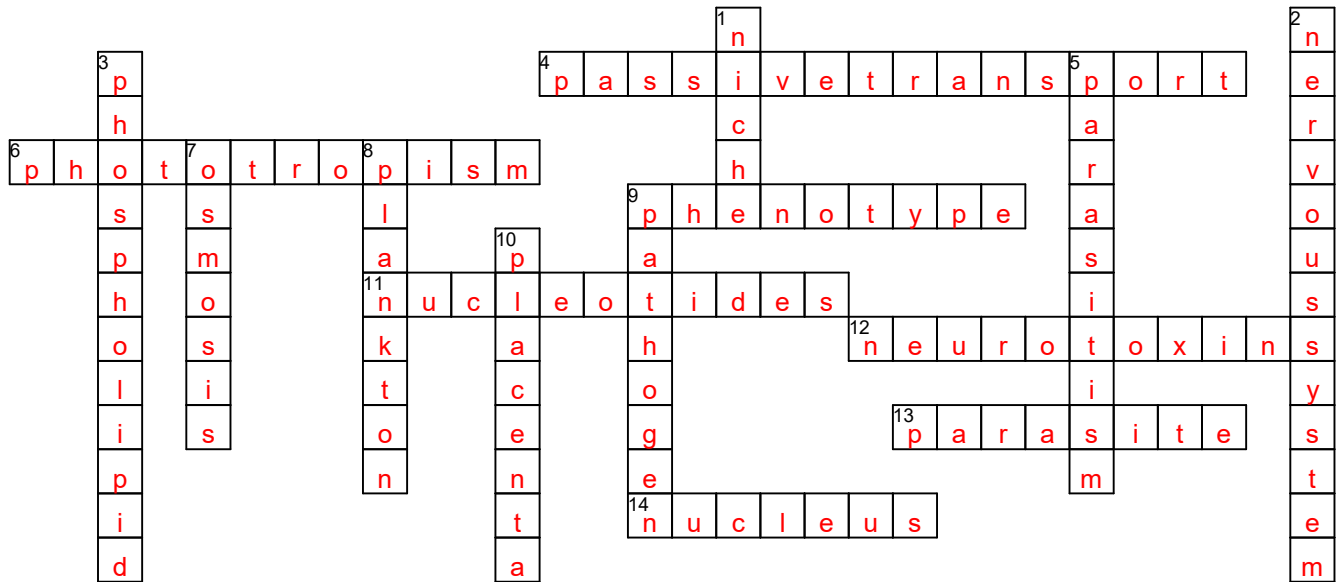


Biology Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 6
