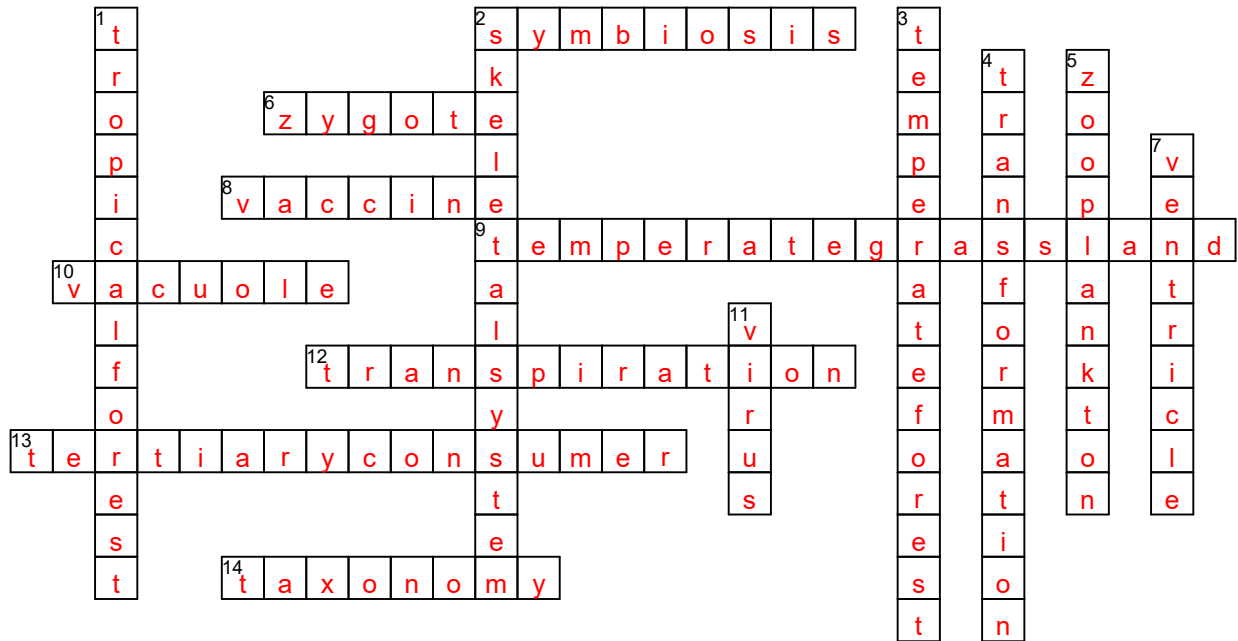


Biology Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 8

8. A harmless variant or derivative of a pathogen that stimulates a host's immune system to mount defenses against the pathogen.
9. A community (or biome) that is dominated by grasses, has few trees, and is characterized by cold winters and rainfall that is intermediate between that of a forest and a desert.
10. Cell organelle that stores materials such as water, salts, proteins, and carbohydrates.

13. An organism that eats secondary consumers.

1. Warm, long days; very diverse; over 200 cm of precipitation per year.
2. Protects and supports body organs and provides a framework the muscles use to support movement. Made up of bones and joints.
3. Biome characterized by broad-leaved, deciduous trees, well-defined seasons, and average yearly precipitation of 75-150 cm.
4. A change in genotype and phenotype due to the assimilation of external DNA by a cell.
5. Tiny floating organisms that are either small animals or protozoa.
7. Bottom portion of the heart, thicker walled and larger.
