| 1. plasma membrane | A selectively-permeable phospholipid bilayer forming the boundary of the cells. |
| 2. pollen | A fine dust that contains the sperm of seed-producing plants. |
| 3. pollination | The transfer of pollen from male reproductive structures to female reproductive structures in plants. |
| 4. population | A group of individuals that belong to the same species and live in the same area. |
| 5. primary consumer | An organism that eats producers. |
| 6. primary succession | Succession that occurs on surfaces where no soil exists. |
| 7. proteins | Nutrients the body uses to build and maintain its cells and tissues. |
| 8. quarternary consumer | An organism that eats tertiary consumers. |
| 9. recessive allele | An allele that is masked when a dominant allele is present. |
| 10. regeneration | The ability to regrow a missing part of the body. |
| 11. respiration | Inhalation and exhalation of air. |
| 12. respiratory system | The organ system that brings oxygen to body cells and removes waste gas. |
| 13. secondary consumer | An organism that eats primary consumers. |
| 14. secondary succession | Type of succession that occurs in an area that was only partially destroyed by disturbances. |
| 15. species | A group of similar organisms that can breed and produce fertile offspring. |
