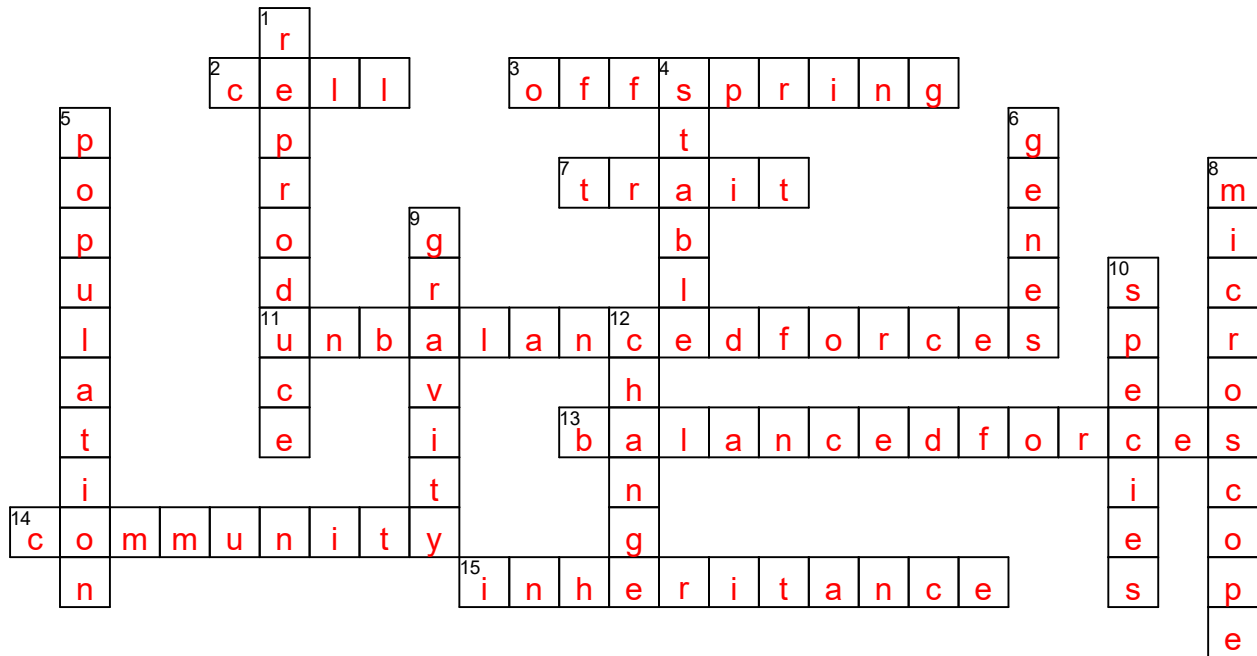


3rd Grade Science Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 2
