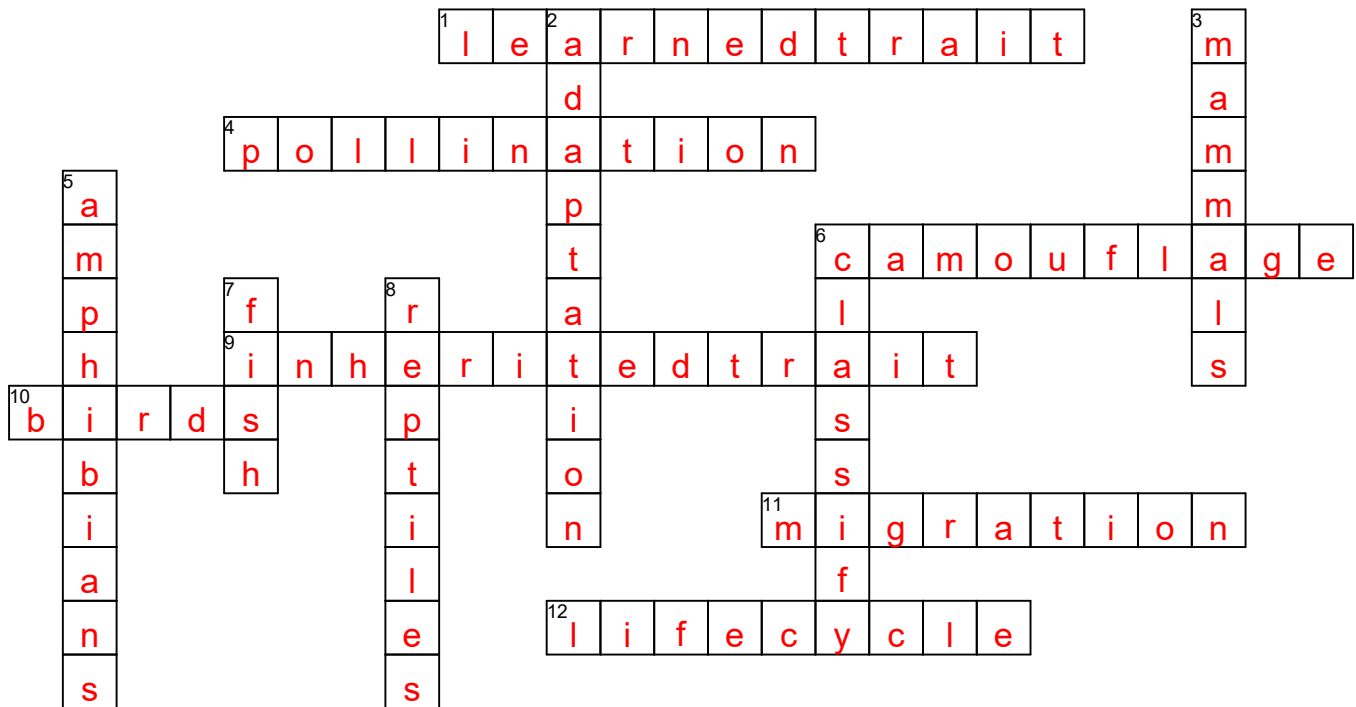


4th Grade Science Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 20

ACROSS

- Behaviors that are learned through experience.
- The transfer of pollen to a stigma, ovule, flower, or plant to allow fertilization.
- The use of any combination of materials, coloration, or illumination for concealment (being hidden), either by making animals, humans, or objects hard to see, or by disguising them as something else.
- Traits that are passed down from parents to their offspring.
- Organisms that hatch from eggs, have wings and feathers.
- Seasonal movement of animals from one region to another.
- The series of changes in the life of an organism including reproduction.

DOWN

- A characteristic or behavior that helps a living thing survive.
- Organisms with warm blood, who drink milk, and sweat when it's warm.
- Organisms born in the water and have gills that become lungs.
- To arrange or sort objects according to their shared characteristics.
- A limbless cold-blooded vertebrate animal with gills and fins and lives wholly in water.
- A vertebrate animal of a class that includes snakes, lizards, crocodiles, turtles, and tortoises. They are distinguished by having a dry scaly skin and typically laying soft-shelled eggs on land.
