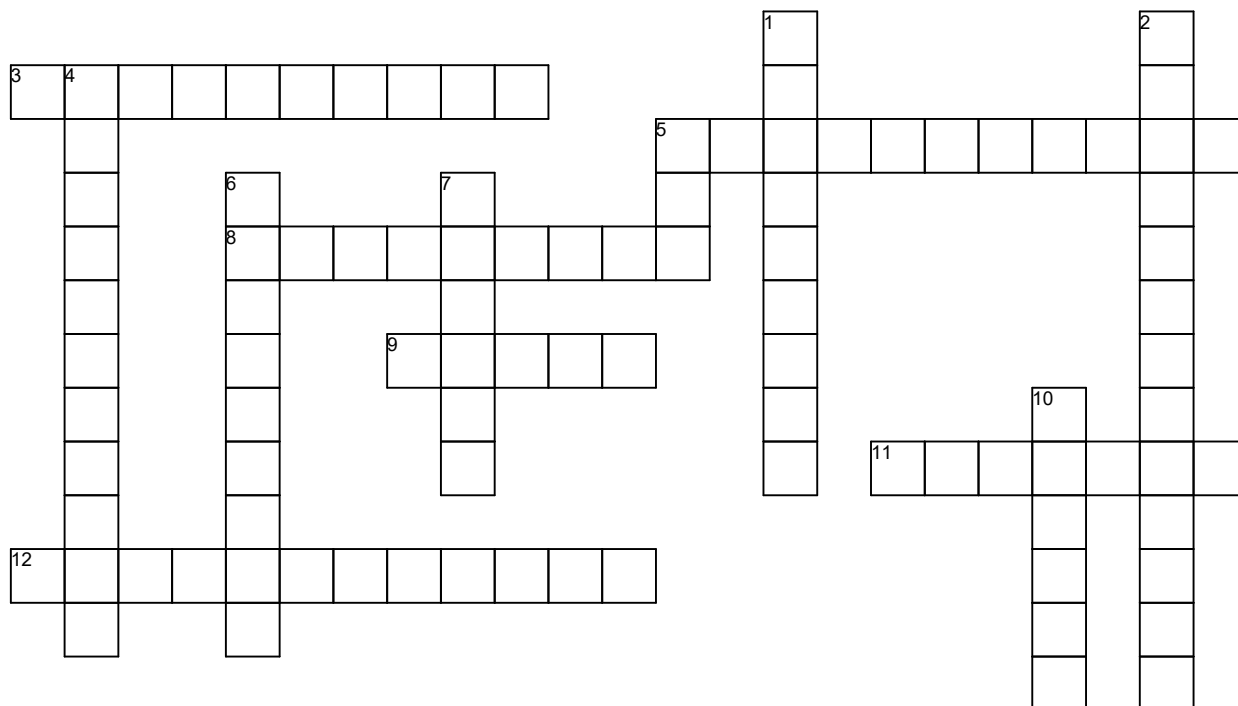


4th Grade Science Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 3
