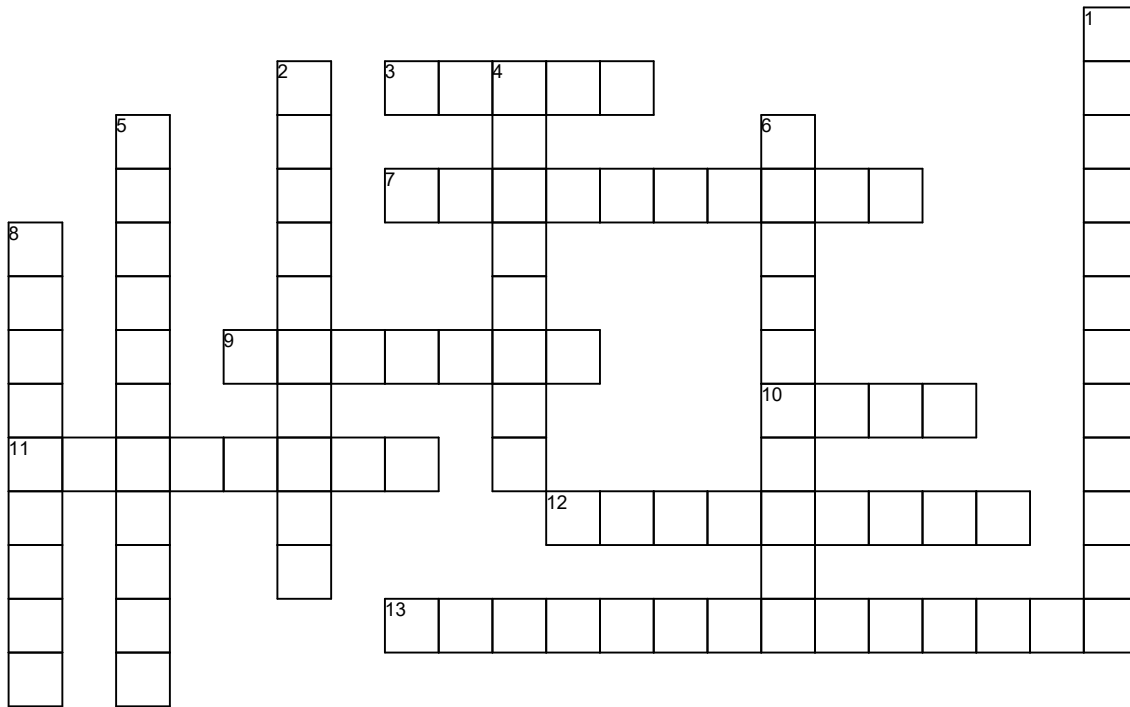


4th Grade Science Vocabulary Crossword Puzzle 5

6. The use of any combination of materials, coloration, or illumination for concealment (being hidden), either by making animals, humans, or objects hard to see, or by disguising them as something else.
