- Water that goes off of the land and collects in rivers, lakes, and the ocean.
- Organisms that make their own food.
- A nearly incompressible fluid that conforms to the shape of its container but retains a (nearly) constant volume independent of pressure.
- Any form of water that falls back to earth.
- All living and nonliving things in an environment and the many ways that they interact with each other.
- The area where an organism lives.
- Organisms that eat other living things.
- Water held underground in the soil or in pores and crevices in rock.
- Energy from the sun heats liquid water and the water changes to water vapor.
