- A method of asexual reproduction; the reproduction of a cell or a one-celled organism by division into two nearly equal parts.
- Green algae that form communities of multicellular spheres; moves by "waves"; mostly asexual reproduction; makes food from sunlight; supplies oxygen to the atmosphere.
- 7. The basic unit of heredity that consists of a segment of DNA on a chromosome.

- 8. The sate of having identical alleles in regard to a given character(s).
- 9. An alternate form of a gene for a specific trait or gene product.
- 10. The genetic makeup of an organism; all the genes that an organism has.
- 11. The genetic material found in all living cells that contains the information needed for an organism to grow, maintain itself, and reproduce.
- 12. Unicellular organism; moves by stretching and bending; asexual reproduction; engulfs and wraps around its food.
- The state of having different alleles in regard to a given character.
- 14. The physical structure in a cell that contains the cell's genetic material.
- 15. Slender threadlike structure that enables many protozoa to swim.
