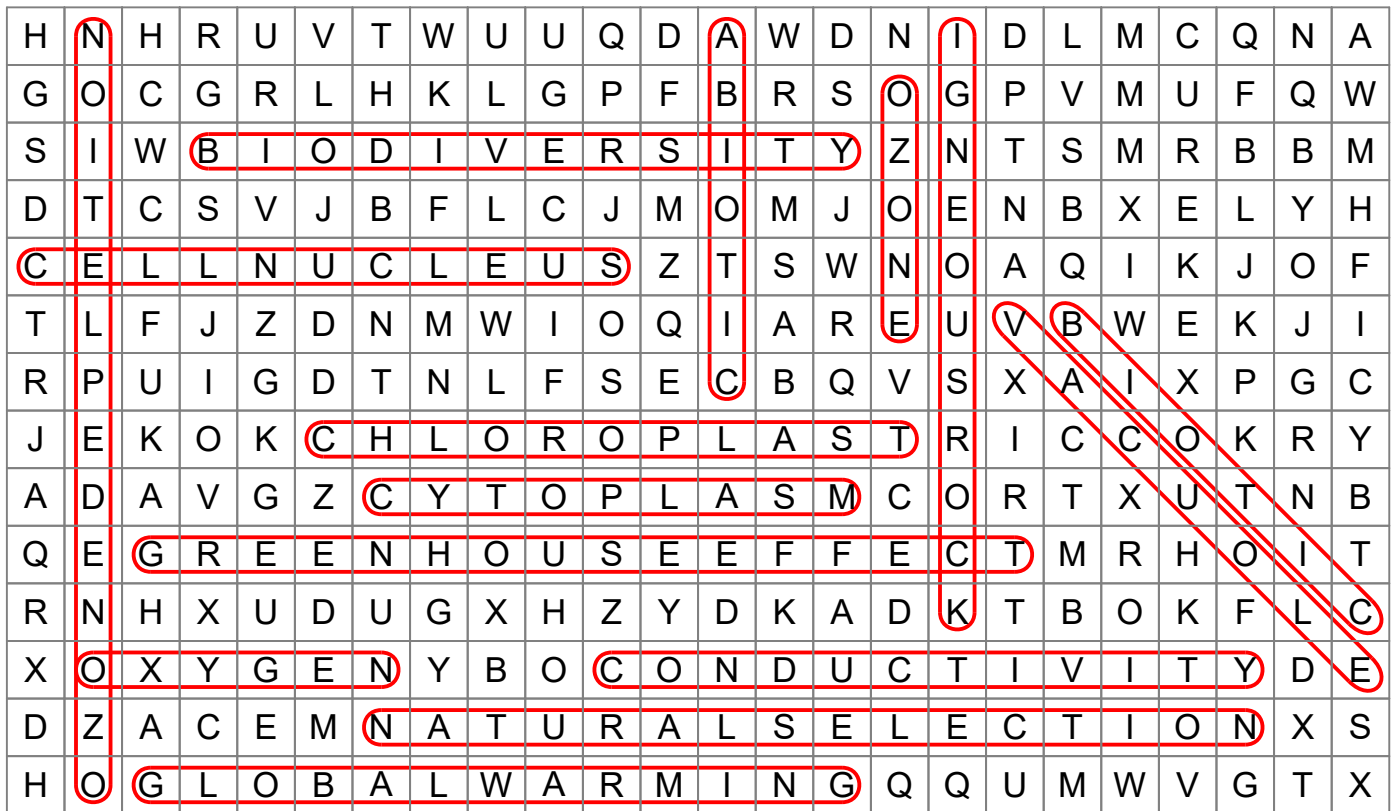

5. Different life; different organisms inhabiting the same area.
6. Not derived from living organisms.
7. The gradual decrease of ozone in the upper atmosphere caused by products using chlorofluorocarbons (CFC's).
8. The control-center of a cell; DNA is stored here.
9. The food production area of a plant cell where photosynthesis occurs.
10. A gas molecule that consists of three oxygen atoms.
11. The process that occurs when gases (CO₂, methane, water vapor) in Earth's atmosphere trap the Sun's heat.
12. Relating to or resulting from living things.
13. The storage area of a cell; this is larger in a plant cell than in an animal cell.
14. A gradual increase in the overall temperature of the earth's atmosphere generally attributed to the greenhouse effect.
