6. Carnivore Animals that eat other animals.

7. Omnivore Animals that eat both plants and animals.

8. Herbivore Animals that eat plants only.

9. Decomposer Break down dead or decaying plant and animal material.

10. Energy Pyramid A diagram that shows the amount of energy at each level of the

ecosystem.

11. Primary Consumer An organism that eats producers.

12. Secondary Consumer An organism that eats primary consumers.

13. Tertiary Consumer An organism that eats secondary consumers.

14. Terrestrial Relating to the land.

15. Aquatic Relating to water.

16. Decomposition The state or process of rotting; decay.
