2.	pupa	The stage of a butterfly's life cycle when it's inside a chrysalis.
3.	antenna	Sensory appendages on a butterfly's head used for sensing the environment.
4.	larva	The caterpillar stage of a butterfly's life cycle.
5.	chrysalis	A protective casing formed by a caterpillar before it becomes a butterfly.
6.	host plant	The specific plant species where a butterfly lays its eggs.
7.	proboscis	A long, coiled tube used by butterflies to drink nectar.
8.	metamorphosis	The transformation process from caterpillar to butterfly.
9.	monarch	A well-known butterfly species known for its long-distance migration.
10.	swallowtail	A family of butterflies with distinctive tail-like extensions on their hindwings.
11.	camouflage	The ability of some butterflies to blend in with their surroundings.
12.	migrate	The seasonal movement of butterflies from one region to another.
13.	scales	Tiny, overlapping structures on a butterfly's wings that create its color patterns.
14.	nymphalidae	A family of butterflies that includes colorful species like the Painted Lady.
15.	mimicry	The resemblance of some butterflies to other objects or harmful species.
16.	habitat	The natural environment where a specific butterfly species lives.
17.	pheromone	Chemical substances released by butterflies to communicate with each other.
