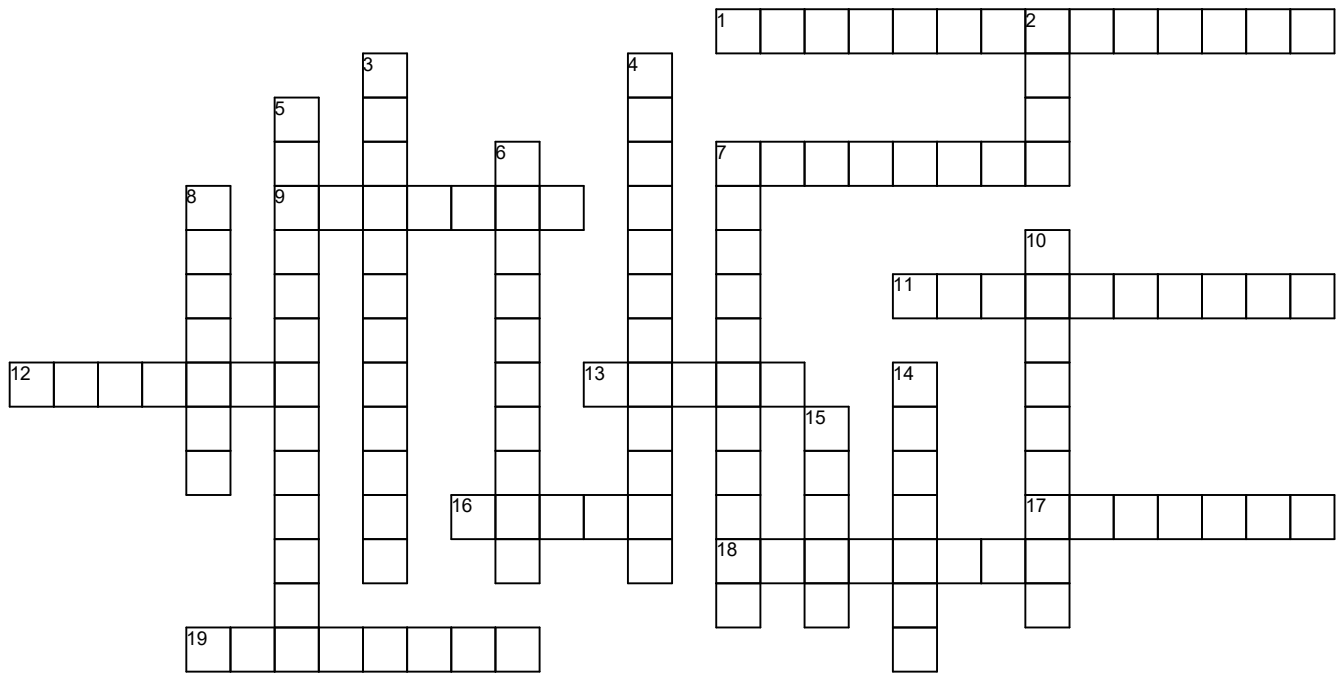


Earth Crossword Puzzle
