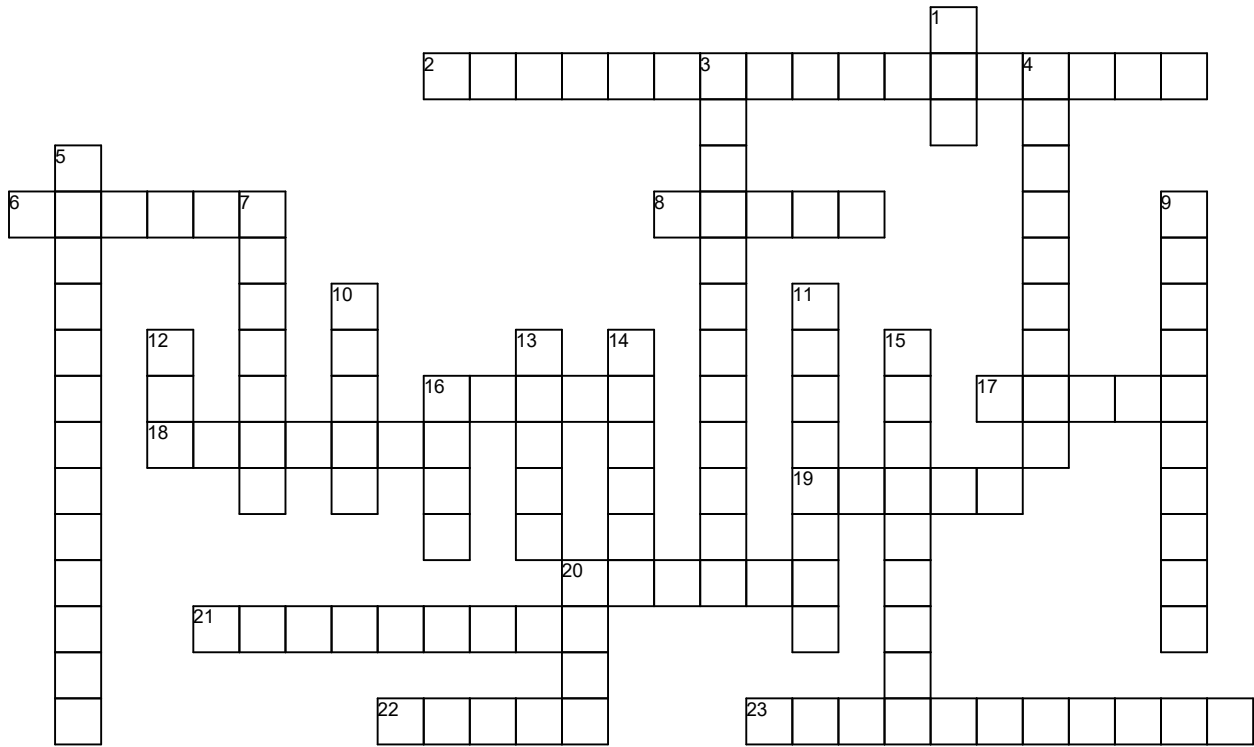


Map Terms Crossword Puzzle
