- 1. stanza A group of lines in a poem.
- 2. rhyme Words that have the same ending sound.
- 3. metaphor A figure of speech that compares two things without using "like" or "as."
- 4. simile A figure of speech that compares two things using "like" or "as."
- 5. haiku A short poem with three lines and a 5-7-5 syllable pattern.
- 6. alliteration The repetition of initial consonant sounds in a line of poetry.
- 7. personification Giving human qualities to non-human objects or animals.
- <sup>8.</sup> onomatopoeia Words that imitate the sound they represent (e.g., buzz, boom).
- <sup>9.</sup> rhyme scheme The pattern of rhyming words at the end of lines in a poem.
- <sup>10.</sup> imagery Words or phrases that create vivid sensory experiences in poetry.
- <sup>11.</sup> meter A regular pattern of stressed and unstressed syllables in a line of poetry.
- <sup>12.</sup> couplet Two consecutive lines of poetry that rhyme and often have the same meter.
- <sup>13.</sup> repetition The use of the same word or phrase multiple times in a poem for emphasis.
- <sup>14.</sup> symbolism Using objects or words to represent deeper meanings or ideas in a poem.
