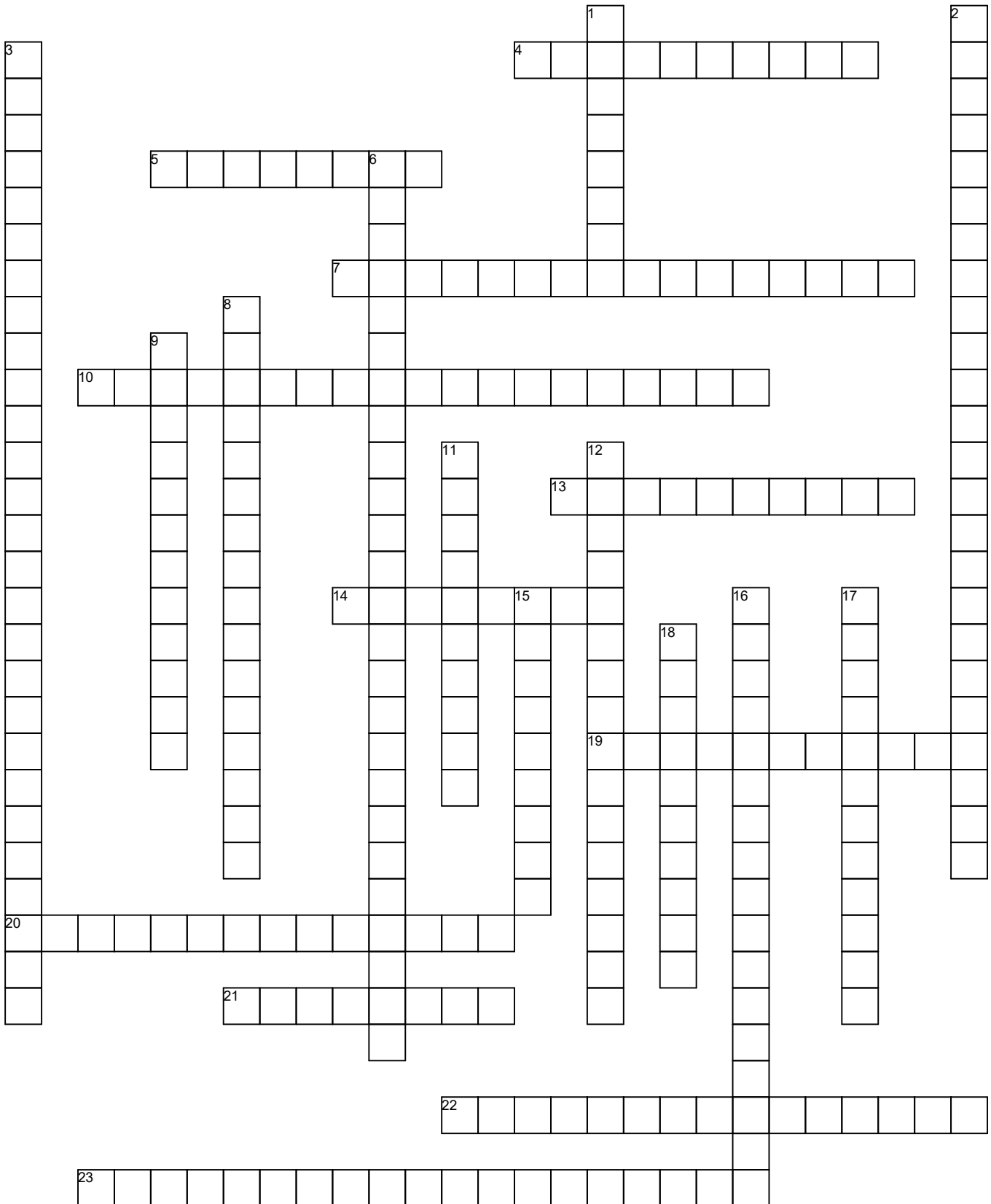


Veterans Day Crossword Puzzle
