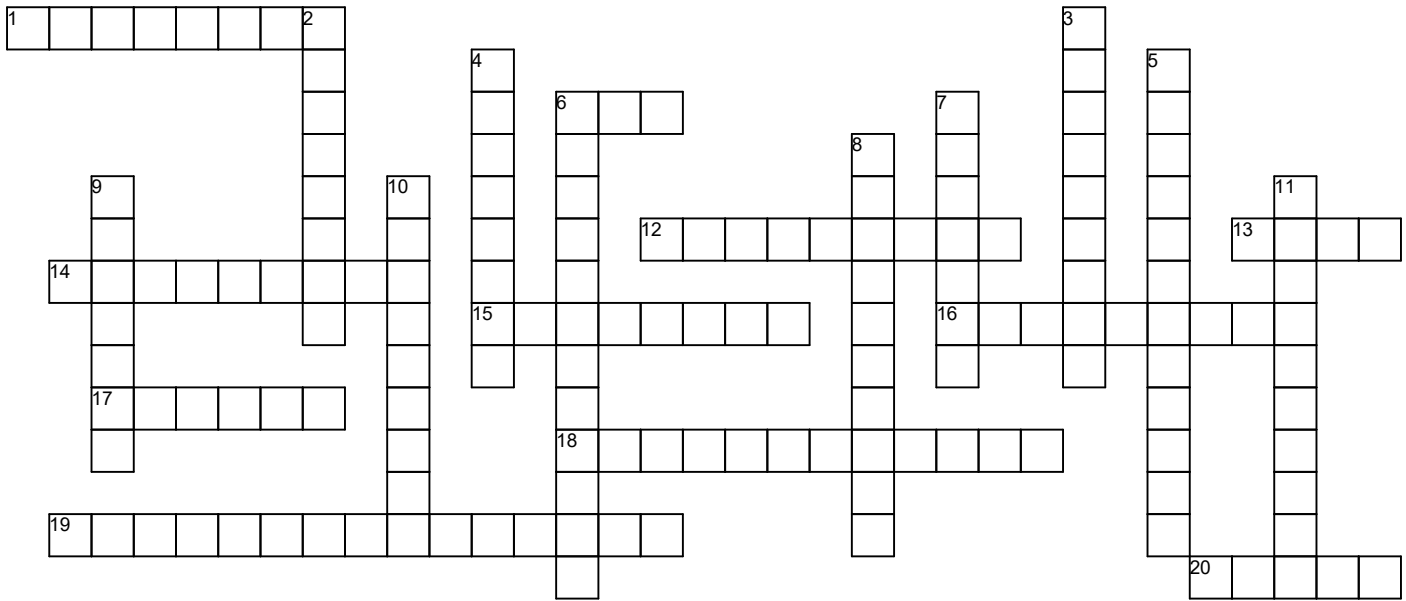


Thanksgiving Crossword Puzzle
