
African American Sports Legends Crossword Puzzle

- 2. Won nine Olympic gold medals in track and field, spanning four different events.
- 3. Set world records in the 100m and 200m sprints that still stand today.
- 12. Won four gold medals in track and field at the 1936 Berlin Olympics, defying Hitler's ideology of Aryan supremacy.
- 14. Broke the color barrier in Major League Baseball, becoming the first African American player in the modern era.
- 15. Dominant golfer who has won numerous major championships and redefined the sport's landscape.
- 16. Broke Babe Ruth's home run record, finishing his career with 755 home runs.
- First American woman to win three gold medals in track and field at a single Olympics.
- 18. Olympic gymnast who became the first African American to win the individual all-around event.
- 19. Broke the color barrier in tennis, becoming the first African American to win a Grand Slam title.
- 20. Holds the most Grand Slam titles in singles, doubles, and mixed doubles combined among active players.

- Led the Boston Celtics to 11 NBA championships, the most by any player in league history.
- 4. Legendary basketball player known for his flashy style and leadership on the court.
- 5. First African American man to win Wimbledon, the US Open, and the Australian Open.
- Widely regarded as the greatest basketball player of all time, winning six NBA championships with the Chicago Bulls.
- 7. Highly accomplished tennis player who has won seven Grand Slam singles titles.
- 8. Hall of Fame football player who set numerous records and became an icon for social activism.
- 9. Renowned boxer who became the first three-time heavyweight champion of the world.
- 10. Holds the world record in the 100m and 200m sprints and is widely considered the fastest man alive.
- 11. Olympic swimmer who became the first African American woman to win an individual gold medal in swimming.
- 13. Considered one of the greatest gymnasts of all time, winning multiple Olympic gold medals.
