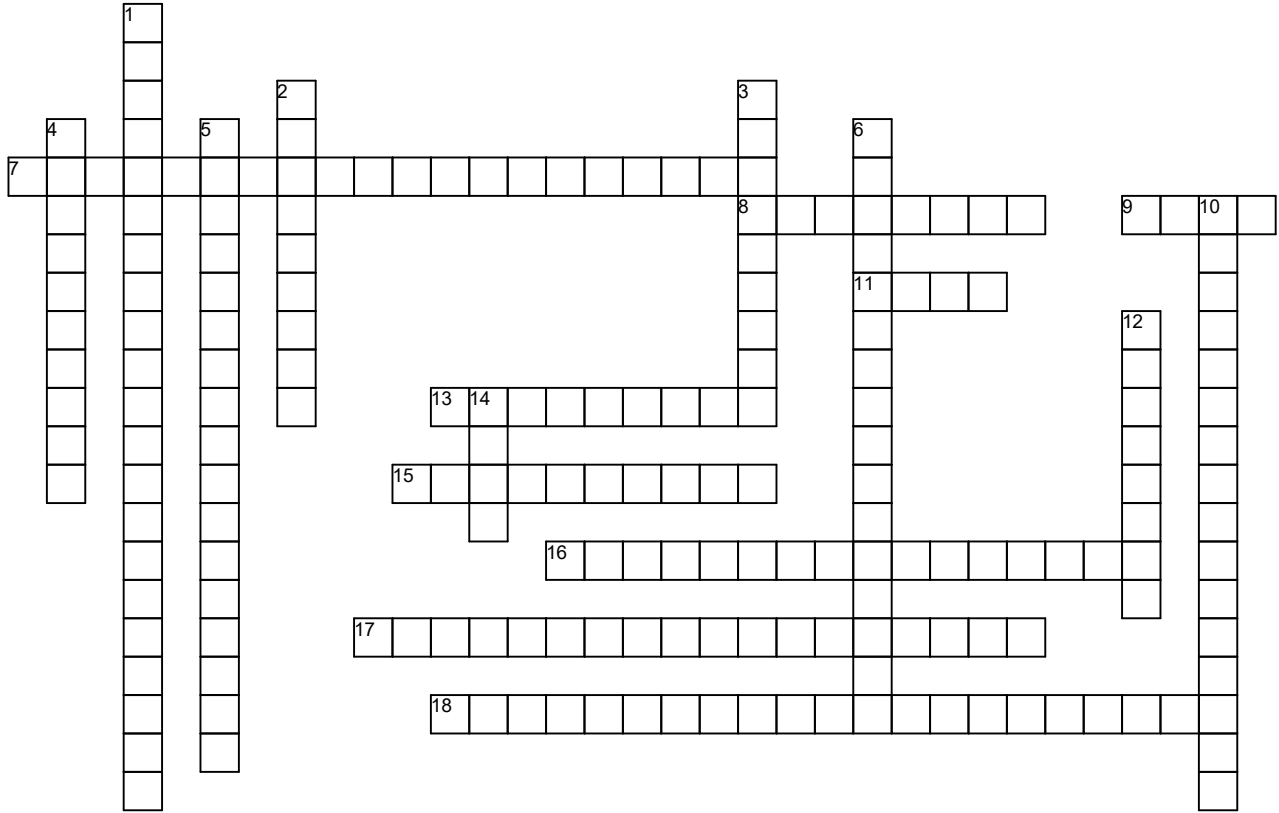


# President Harrison Crossword Puzzle
