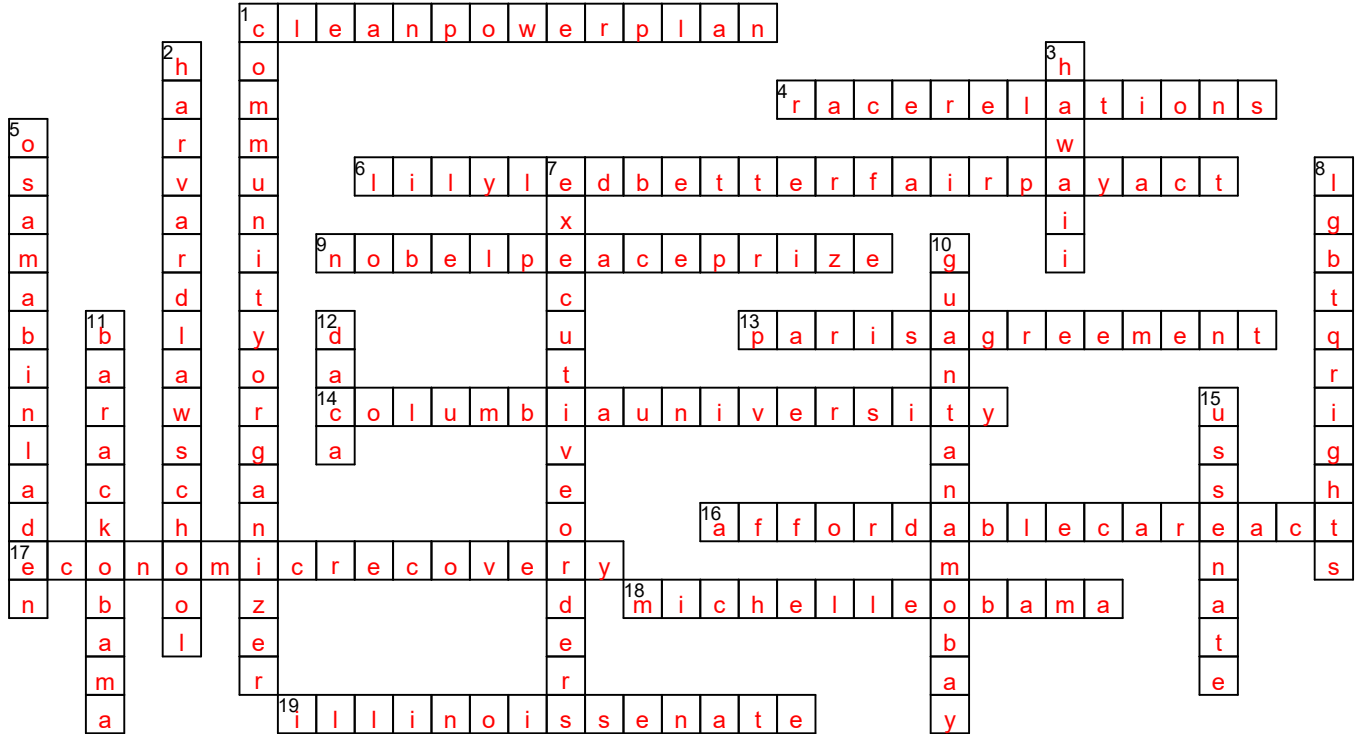


President Obama Crossword Puzzle
