
Famous Women Athletes Crossword Puzzle

- Tennis champion and former world No. 1 player, known for her powerful serve and aggressive playing style.

- 5. Olympic swimmer and the first African-American woman to win an individual Olympic gold medal in swimming.
- 6. Tennis champion with multiple Grand Slam titles, considered one of the greatest players of all time.
- Speed skater and multiple Olympic gold medalist, one of the most decorated female athletes in Winter Olympics history.
- Track and field athlete known as "Flo-Jo," she set world records in the 100m and 200m sprints that still stand today.

- 17. Soccer player and two-time Olympic gold medalist, known for her clutch performances and leadership on the field.
