2.	Pennsylvania	The state where James Buchanan was born in 1791.
3.	Wheatland	Estate in Pennsylvania where Buchanan lived before and after his presidency.
4.	Harriet Lane	Niece of James Buchanan who served as his White House hostess, acting as the de facto First Lady.
5.	Bachelor President	Nickname given to James Buchanan for being the only president who never married.
6.	Franklin Pierce	Predecessor of James Buchanan as President of the United States.
7.	Democratic Party	Political party to which James Buchanan belonged.
8.	Cabinet	Group of advisors who served under Buchanan during his presidency.
9.	Pennsylvania Legislature	James Buchanan served in this before becoming President.
10.	William Rufus King	Close friend of James Buchanan, serving as Vice President during part of Franklin Pierce's term.
11.	Inauguration	Event where Buchanan took the oath of office as President in 1857.
12.	Lecompton Constitution	Pro-slavery constitution proposed for Kansas, which was supported by Buchanan.
13.	Washington, D.C.	Location of Buchanan's presidency, where he faced increasing sectional tensions.
14.	Panic of 1857	Economic downturn that occurred early in Buchanan's presidency, causing financial hardship for many Americans.
15.	Farewell Address	Speech delivered at the end of Buchanan's presidency, reflecting on the state of the nation.
16.	James Polk	President under which Buchanan served as Secretary of State, contributing to expansionist policies.
17.	Democratic National Convention	Event where Buchanan was nominated as the presidential candidate in 1856.
18.	Buchanan v. Warley	Supreme Court case in which the Court struck down racial zoning laws.
19.	Compromise of 1850	Legislation aimed at addressing the issue of slavery in the territories.
20.	Kansas-Nebraska Act	Controversial legislation that allowed settlers in the Kansas and Nebraska territories to decide whether to allow slavery.
