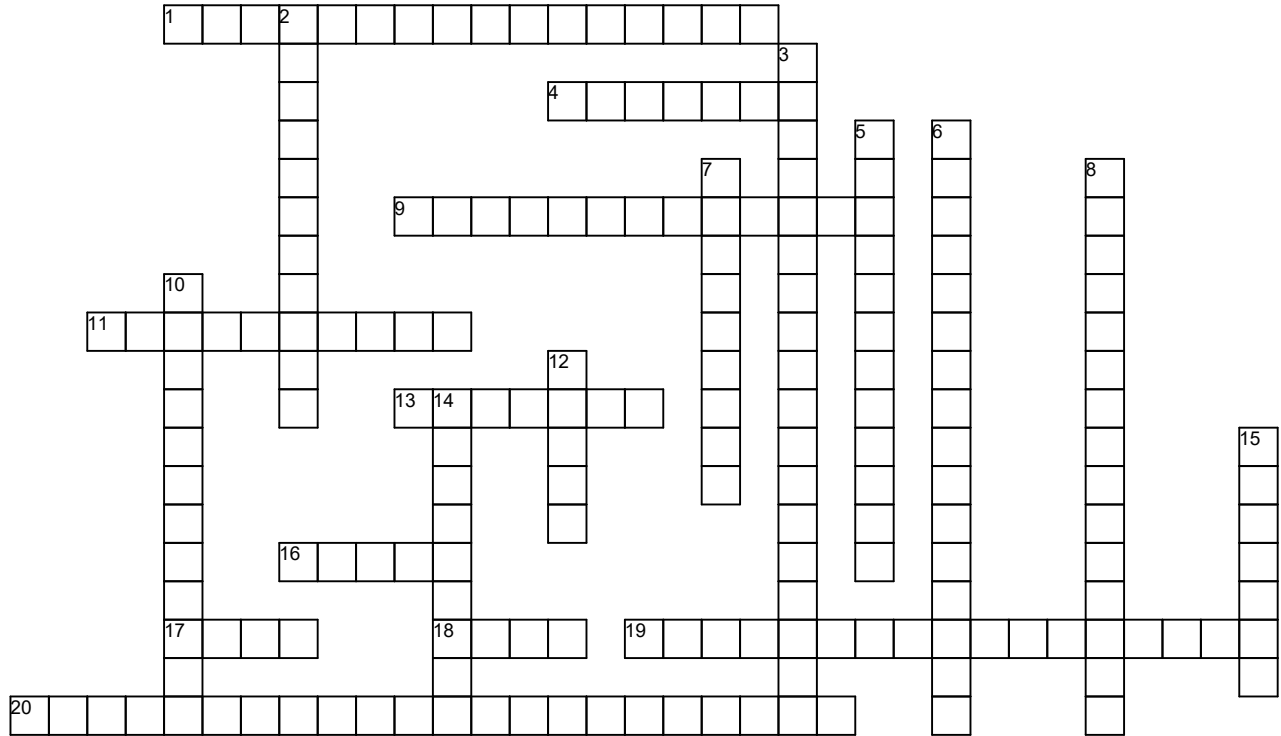


# President Taylor Crossword Puzzle

## ACROSS

1. The major legislative package passed during Taylor's presidency, aimed at easing tensions between free and slave states.
