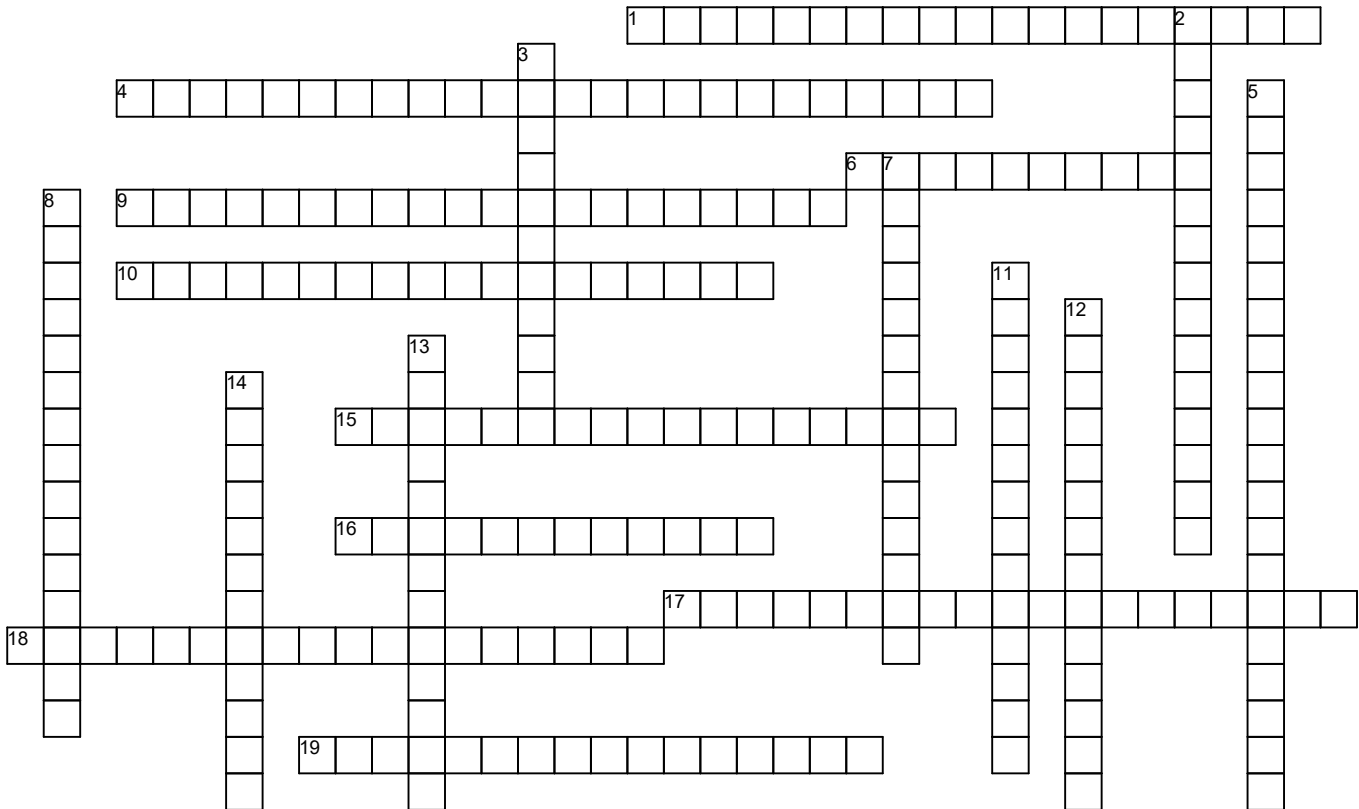


President Grant Crossword Puzzle

1. Full name of the 18th president.
4. Grant signed legislation authorizing its construction. The first one to span the continent.

9. Location where Robert E. Lee surrendered to Grant, effectively ending the Civil War.
10. Controversy during Grant's administration involving bribery and tax evasion.
15. Grant's successful siege of this Confederate stronghold was a turning point in the Civil War.
16. Key Confederate stronghold captured by Grant in 1862.
17. Union victory led by Grant, securing control of Tennessee.
18. Grant served as a junior officer in this conflict prior to the Civil War.
19. Point Pleasant, Ohio.
