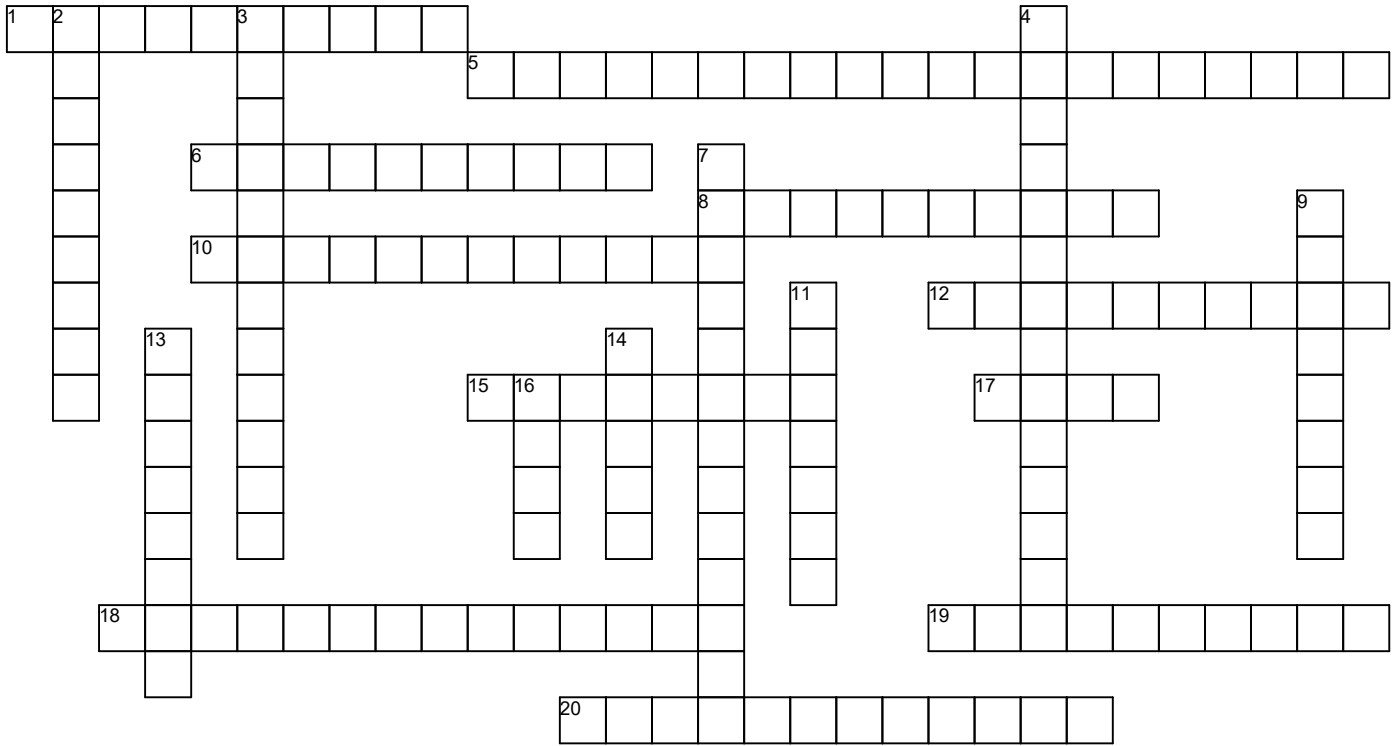


President Hayes Crossword Puzzle
