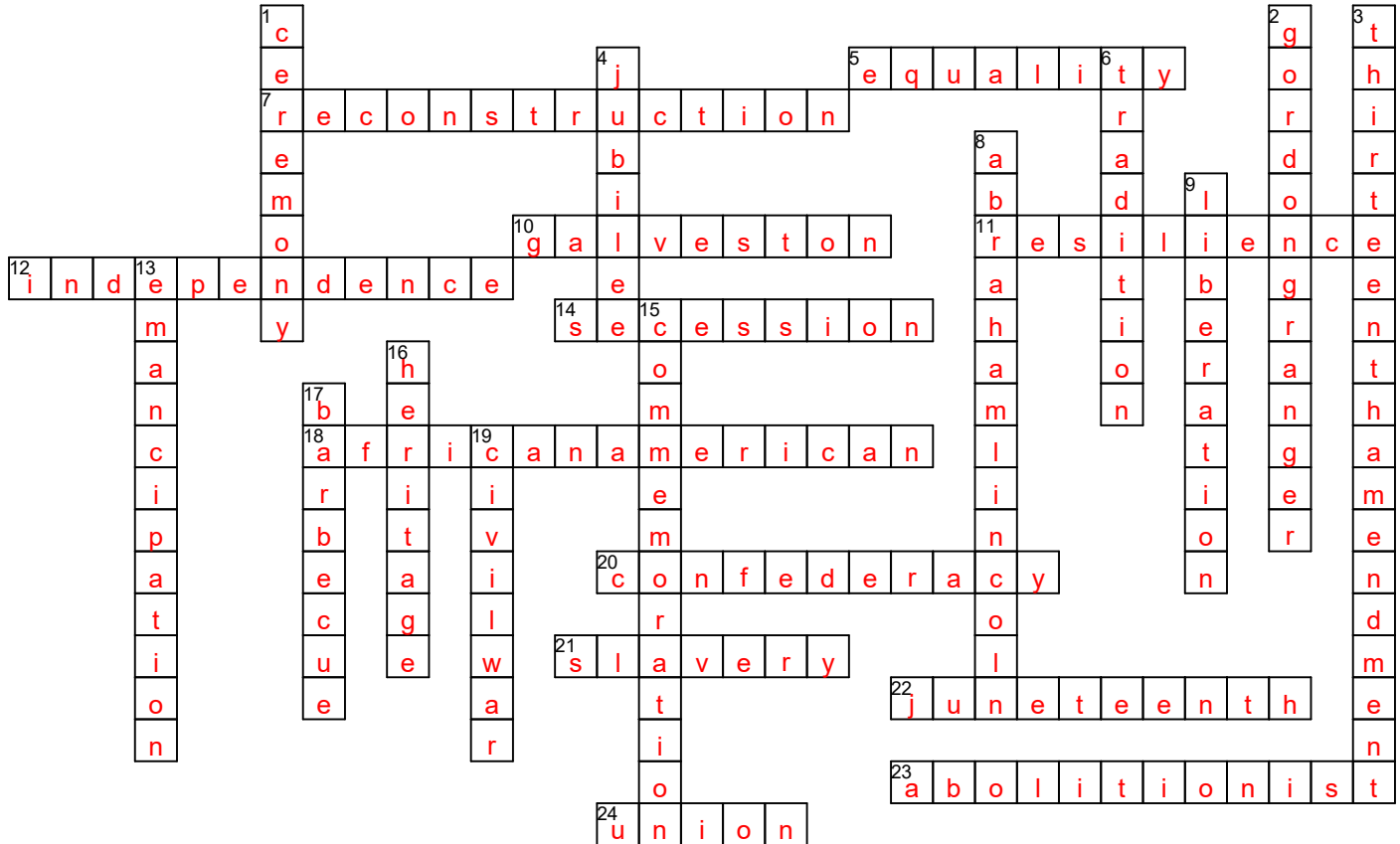


Juneteenth Crossword Puzzle
