2. Legolas The elf who is a skilled archer and part of the Fellowship.
3. Gimli The dwarf warrior and member of the Fellowship.
4. Frodo The hobbit who continues his journey to Mordor with the One Ring.
5. Sam Frodo's loyal companion and friend.
6. Gollum The creature who guides Frodo and Sam to Mordor.
7. Gandalf The wizard who returns as Gandalf the White.
8. Saruman The white wizard who allies with Sauron and betrays the Fellowship.
9. Treebeard The ent who helps Merry and Pippin.
10. Merry One of the hobbits who ends up with the ents.
11. Pippin The other hobbit who joins Merry with the ents.
12. Rohan The kingdom ruled by King Theoden.
13. Theoden The king of Rohan who is freed from Saruman's influence.
14. Eowyn The niece of King Theoden who disguises herself as a man to fight.
15. Eomer The nephew of King Theoden and a marshal of the Riddermark.
16. Helm's Deep The fortress where a major battle takes place.
17. Isengard Saruman's stronghold.
18. Fangorn The forest where the ents live.
19. Grima The advisor who betrays Theoden to Saruman.
20. Shadowfax Gandalf's swift and intelligent horse.
21. Faramir The brother of Boromir who encounters Frodo and Sam.
22. Osgiliath The ruined city where Faramir takes Frodo and Sam.
23. Black Gate The entrance to Mordor guarded by Sauron's forces.
24. Shelob The giant spider that Frodo and Sam encounter.
