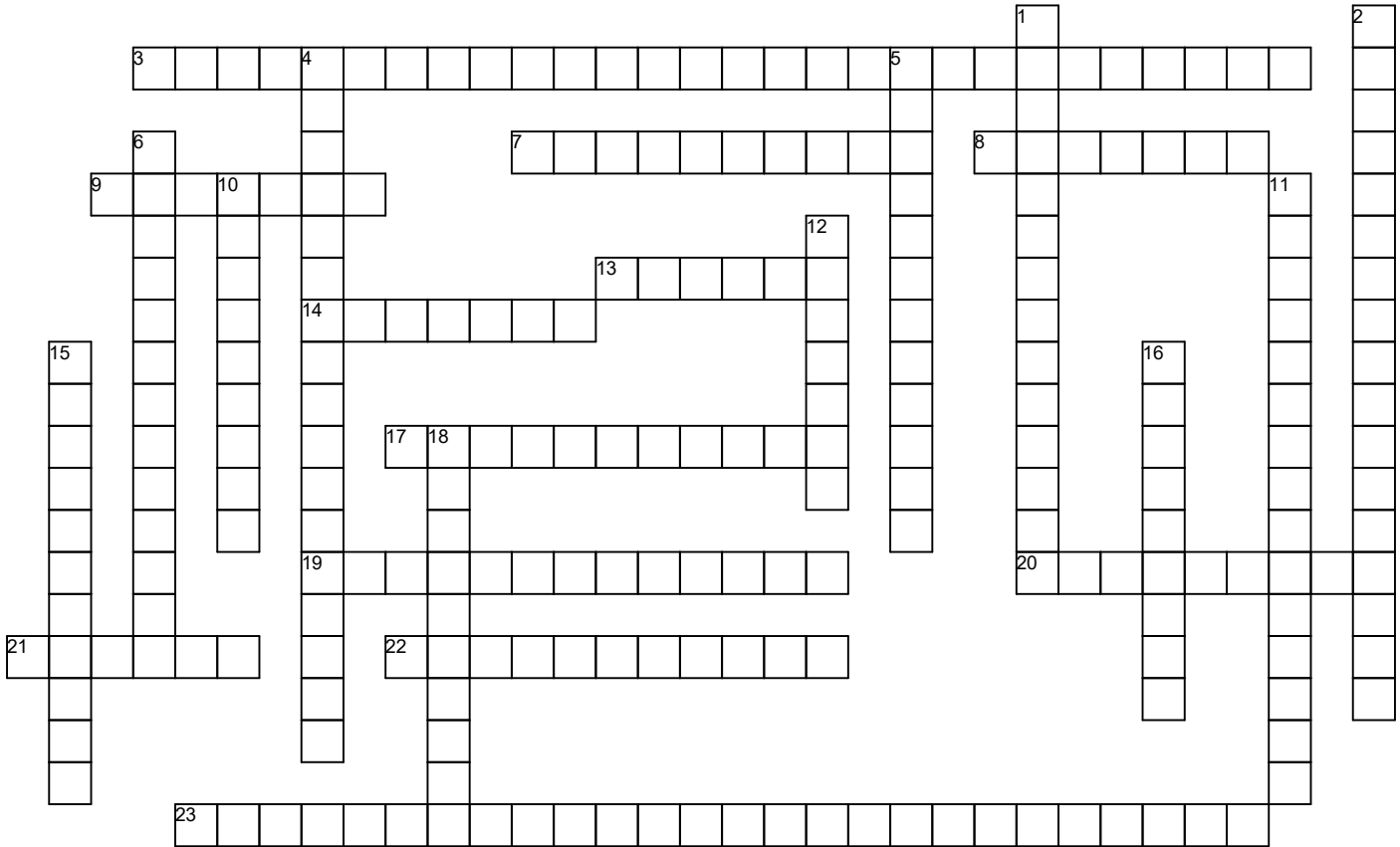


Cesar Chavez Crossword Puzzle
