- 8. Miep Gies The woman who helped hide the families and brought them supplies.
- 9. Mr. Dussel The dentist who joined the group in hiding and shared a room with Anne.
- 10. Secret Annex The hidden area of Otto Frank's business where the families hid.
- 11. Amsterdam The city in which Anne and her family hid during the German occupation.
- 12. Nazi The political party that came to power in Germany and persecuted Jews.
- 13. Star of David A symbol that Jews were forced to wear during the Nazi regime.

14. World War II The global conflict during which Anne wrote her diary.

- 15. concentration camp The place where Anne and her family were sent after being discovered.
- 16. Gestapo The secret police who arrested the occupants of the secret annex.
- 17. Westerbork The first camp to which Anne and her family were sent after their arrest.
- 18. Bergen-Belsen The concentration camp where Anne and Margot died.
- 19. Kitty The imaginary friend to whom Anne addressed her diary entries.
- 20. Hanukkah The Jewish holiday that the families in the annex celebrated together.
- 21. ration books The means by which Miep Gies obtained food for those in hiding.
- 22. fear A recurring theme in Anne's diary, felt by all in the annex.
- 23. hope A feeling that Anne clung to, even in the darkest moments.
- 24. silence Something the residents of the annex had to maintain during the day to avoid detection.
