1. vampire A mythological creature that drinks blood and avoids sunlight.
2. pumpkin A round, orange vegetable often carved for Halloween.
3. broomstick A tool often associated with witches for flying.
4. black cat An animal said to bring bad luck when it crosses your path.
5. ghost The spirit of a dead person, often depicted as a white figure.
6. zombie A reanimated corpse often seen in horror movies.
7. costume Something you wear to dress up as another character or figure.
8. haunted house A spooky place believed to be inhabited by spirits.
9. skeleton The bone structure of a human or animal, often seen in Halloween decorations.
10. bat A flying mammal often associated with vampires and Halloween.
11. trick or treat A phrase kids say to get candy from neighbors on Halloween.
12. full moon An astronomical event linked to werewolves and other Halloween creatures.
13. cauldron A large pot used by witches for brewing potions.
14. spider An eight-legged creature often used as a creepy Halloween decoration.
15. jack-o'-lantern A carved pumpkin with a glowing face.
16. witch A person, often female, believed to practice magic, often depicted with a pointed hat.
17. cobweb A structure made by spiders, often seen in haunted places.
18. Frankenstein A famous monster created by Mary Shelley.
19. werewolf A human who transforms into a wolf during a full moon.
20. candy corn A popular yellow, orange, and white Halloween candy.
21. scarecrow A figure made of straw, often placed in fields to scare birds, sometimes used in Halloween decorations.
22. potion A magical liquid often brewed by witches in stories.
23. mummy An ancient Egyptian body wrapped in cloth, brought back to life in horror tales.
24. graveyard A place where the dead are buried, often depicted as spooky in Halloween stories.
