Mockingjay The symbol of rebellion used throughout the series.

6. Effie The Capitol escort who helps Katniss and Peeta during the Games.

7. President Snow The ruthless leader of Panem.

8. Prim Katniss' younger sister, whose name is initially drawn for the Games.

9. Arena The location where the tributes fight to the death.

10. Cornucopia The central point in the arena where supplies are placed at the start of the

Games.

11. Rue The young girl from District 11 who befriends Katniss in the arena.

12. District 12 The coal-mining district where Katniss and her family live.

13. Tracker Jackers Deadly genetically engineered wasps used as a weapon.

14. Tributes The name given to the children selected to participate in the Hunger Games.

15. Capitol The city that controls the districts of Panem and where the Games are

orchestrated.

16. Haymitch The former victor who serves as a mentor to Katniss and Peeta.

17. bread Symbolizes hope and survival, often linked to Peeta.

18 fire A symbol of Katniss' fiery spirit and strength.

19 Jabberjays Mutated birds originally created by the Capitol to spy on enemies.

20. Nightlock Poisonous berries that almost result in a double suicide at the end of the Games.

21. rebellion The uprising against the Capitol that begins after the Games.

22. Careers Tributes from wealthier districts who train for the Games and volunteer to

compete.

23. Caesar Flickerman The charismatic host of the televised Hunger Games interviews.
