1. John Adams The second president of the United States.
2. Braintree Town in Massachusetts where John Adams was born.
3. Harvard The college where John Adams was educated.
4. lawyer Adams' profession before entering politics.
5. Boston Massacre Adams defended British soldiers involved in this 1770 event.
6. Continental Congress Adams served as a delegate to this revolutionary body.
7. independence Adams was a key advocate for this during the American Revolution.
8. Thomas Jefferson This president defeated Adams in the election of 1800.
9. Declaration of Independence Document that Adams helped push for in 1776.
10. France Adams negotiated with this country during the Quasi-War.
11. Vice President Adams was the first to hold this office under George Washington.
12. Quasi War Undeclared naval conflict with France during Adams' presidency.
13. Alien and Sedition Controversial acts passed during Adams' presidency.
14. Treaty of Paris Agreement that officially ended the Revolutionary War, where Adams played a key role.
15. Abigail Adams' wife and close advisor.
16. diplomacy Adams' use of this helped avoid full-scale war with France.
17. July Fourth The date on which Adams passed away in 1826.
18. Massachusetts The state where John Adams was born and retired.
19. Quincy Town in Massachusetts where Adams spent his retirement.
20. Minister to France Adams served as this during the Revolutionary War.
21. reconciliation Adams and Jefferson achieved this in their later years through letters.
