2. Mount Vernon The name of Washington's estate in Virginia.
3. Martha First name of Washington's wife.
4. Revolution War in which Washington served as commander-in-chief of the Continental Army.
5. Yorktown Site of the final major battle of the American Revolution, led by Washington.
6. surveyor Washington's early profession before entering military and political life.
7. Virginia The colony where Washington was born.
8. President Washington was the first to hold this title in the United States.
9. neutrality Washington's policy regarding foreign wars during his presidency.
10. cabinet A group of advisors created by Washington to help him govern.
11. Farewell Address Washington's famous speech warning against political parties and foreign alliances.
12. Trenton Site of Washington's surprise victory after crossing the Delaware River.
13. Federalist Washington's political views aligned with this early American political faction.
14. two terms Washington set the precedent of serving this many times as president.
15. French and Indian The war in which Washington gained his first military experience.
16. John Adams Washington's Vice President who succeeded him as President.
17. dollar Washington's face appears on this currency note.
18. Constitutional Convention The 1787 meeting where Washington was chosen to preside and helped shape the U.S. Constitution.
19. militia The Virginia group that Washington joined early in his military career.
20. Princeton Another important battle Washington won shortly after the victory at Trenton.
21. Founding Father Washington is many times called this.
22. cherry tree A famous, though likely fictional, story about young Washington involves this type of tree.
