
AP US History Crossword Puzzle Review 12

- A cavalry unit led by Theodore Roosevelt in the Spanish-American War.
- An extension of the Monroe
 Doctrine stating that the U.S. could intervene in Latin America to maintain stability.
- Henry Clay's economic plan promoting protective tariffs, a national bank, and internal improvements.
- 11. A 1830 law that forced Native American tribes to relocate west of the Mississippi River.
- 13. A war between the U.S. and Britain (1812-1815) over trade restrictions and impressment of sailors.
